








Kimpton Cardinal Hotel

The 174-room, downtown Kimpton Cardinal Hotel is located in the historic 1929 R.J. Reynolds Tobacco headquarters building, which was the architectural muse for New York City's Empire State Building. The first Kimpton in the Carolinas, the Cardinal offers a French-inspired restaurant and bar, a nearly 2,000-square-foot rec room, and 6,375 square feet of inspired meeting space.



Boasting 146 two-room suites, the centrally located Embassy Suites Winston-Salem is connected directly via enclosed skywalk to both the Marriott Winston-Salem and the Benton Convention Center. Walkable to shops, restaurants and the downtown Arts District. Additional group functions are easily accommodated in the 8,300-square-foot Garden Terrace.

Hotel Indigo

Hotel Indigo occupies a 1928 Art Deco landmark, the Pepper Building. Capturing the eclectic vibe of Winston-Salem's historic heritage and growing tech industry, local artists' work accentuates the boutique hotel's walls. Stay in one of 75 trendy guest rooms, dine at Sir Winston Restaurant and Wine Loft, and meet in the hotel's 1,600 square feet of refined event space.





Courtyard by Marriott WS

Featuring the city's first hotel rooftop bar, Top of Fourth, the 126-room Courtyard by Marriott offers 1,800 square feet of sophisticated meeting and entertainment space. Perfect for admiring the view of Winston-Salem's skyline or hosting an impromptu gathering around the firepit on the spacious outdoor patio.

Hampton Inn & Suites WS

Located in the heart of downtown, the 119-room Hampton Inn & Suites is an ideal place to meet, play, and stay. Complimentary breakfast, free WiFi, and on-site parking appeal to the busy meeting planner. This property boasts a contemporary 1,400-square-foot meeting room, cityscape outdoor pool, and 24/7 fitness center.



Want a meeting space with history, style, and personality? Winston-Salem has you covered in the heart of downtown with venues to accommodate groups large and small.

The Millennium Center, once the area's post office and federal building, is an elegant three-story, 72,000-square-foot venue located in Winston-Salem's Downtown Arts District. The Millennium Center offers a variety of meeting spaces and settings for up to 1,500 along with onsite catering and audiovisual services.

The Stevens Center, built in 1929, is a downtown theater with seating for 1,300 and a 10th floor reception hall with 2,500 square feet of meeting space. The venue closed temporarily for a multi-year, \$81 million renovation beginning November 2023.

Footnote, centrally located downtown, is a flexible event space ideal for up to 250. Enjoy full catering, bar service and audiovisual capabilities along with the convenience of Footnote's sister property, Foothills Brewing next door.

The Milton Rhodes Center for

the Arts is a dynamic multipurpose event venue located downtown. This "Arts Campus" includes Hanesbrands Theatre (300 seats), a black-box design with state-of-the-art lighting, projection, and audio systems. The Reynolds Place Theatre (250 seats) and Mountcastle Forum Theatre (125 seats) provide special ambiance.

Colleges and Universities abound

in Winston-Salem, with flexible meeting spaces at Salem College, Wake Forest University, Winston-Salem State University, and UNC School of the Arts.

The Ramkat is a two-level, 11,670-square-foot, 1,000-person-capacity live music venue, handicap-accessible, and serviced by three bars serving a wide variety of beer, wine, spirits and non-alcoholic beverages.

Artful + Iconic

Innovation Quarter was built on the foundation of historic tobacco warehouses and is now a sprawling urban center, home to cutting-edge technology and iconic meeting space.

Bailey Power Plant boasts several innovative meeting spaces inside a redeveloped, historic building. The Crane Room at Turbine Hall includes a large open area, which accommodates up to 300 people, plus four meeting rooms. This eye-catching venue also features two shipping-container like-pods with flexible seating for up to 25 people.

Bailey Park encompasses 1.6 acres of publicly accessible green space in the heart of Innovation Quarter. Just a five-minute walk from the city center, Bailey Park is a multi-use outdoor space, complete with a natural amphitheater and covered stage. Perfect for meetings, receptions, and team building.

Wake Forest Biotech Place

provides a main level conference center with 15 rooms, including a 120-person auditorium, five meeting rooms, six boardrooms, a long-distance learning classroom, and a four-story, 7,500-square-foot atrium with a 14-foot video screen. Ideal for gatherings up to 500 guests.

Kaleideum, opened in February 2024, this fun \$40 million museum includes four levels, nine interactive exhibits, and a one-of-a-kind rooftop play and party area. Enjoy a variety of cutting-edge event spaces, including a 2,100-square-foot exhibit hall, a 300-person rooftop terrace, Digital Dome Planetarium, and multiple breakout rooms.











Historic + elegant or modern + chic, Winston-Salem offers a variety of unique venues each thoughtfully designed to inspire meetings of any size. From crowd-pleasing stadiums to intimate art galleries, artful urban parks and spacious craft breweries, we've got you covered.

Bridger Field House overlooks
Allegacy Federal Credit Union Stadium,
home of the Wake Forest University's
Demon Deacon football team. This venue
seats up to 400 and offers nearly 5,700
square feet of flexible event space,
including a 2,700-square-foot balcony.

LJVM Coliseum accommodates a range of events, performances, and seating options with more than 25,000 flexible square feet. The 14,744-seat multipurpose arena is home to Wake Forest University's basketball teams.

Truist Stadium is an award-winning downtown ballpark featuring 5,500 stadium-style seats, 16 luxurious suites, and a 200-foot LED outfield wall scoreboard. Home to the Winston-Salem Dash, a Class A-Advanced minor league affiliate of the Chicago White Sox.

The Crest is an impeccably restored vintage structure dating back to 1883.
Great for a corporate soiree, milestone celebration or glamourous gathering.

The North Carolina Museum of Art

is a 32-acre, 1929 estate-turnedcontemporary art museum located along the Reynolda Mile. Ideal for both indoor and outdoor gatherings with expansive grounds and a fully-equipped auditorium, NCMA, WS accommodates up to 300 people.

Winston-Salem Fairgrounds
Arena and Event Center is a 70-acre
multiuse complex just five minutes from
downtown. With more than 55,000 square
feet of flexible event space, including a
4,000-seat multipurpose arena.

Robert Hall is a multipurpose event space and catering kitchen with three distinct venues that can be used separately or together. Walkable to over 100 downtown venues, restaurants and craft breweries.

ROAR is a four-story, 42,000-square-foot dining, entertainment, and event space with a sophistocated Roaring '20s vibe. Amenities include duckpin bowling, digitized mini golf, golf simulators, snack bar, arcade, rooftop bar, and a 90-tap, self-serve beer wall.
